One arm of missions at our church is the Third Grade Outreach at Franklin County Schools. This program reaches out to children in order to give them a hand up. Reading to children helps them to understand grammar and correct sentence structure, builds attention spans, helps hone listening skills, and exposes them to new places and situations.
